Historically, NECA SWW members have raised thousands of dollars for this wonderful organization each year, and this holiday season we want to continue that tradition.

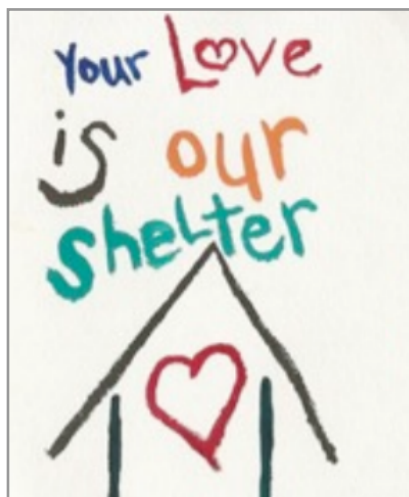


While we cannot meet in person for a fundraising event this year, you can still help Family Renewal Shelter by offering cash donations and/or gift cards.

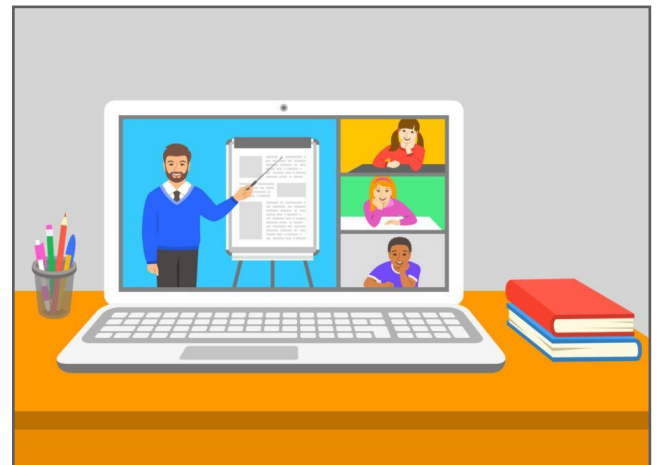
